Extended forecast – Rain and thunderstorms are likely both Thursday and Friday as a frontal boundary drops into northern Florida and stalls. This front is forecast to bring periods of rain with embedded thunderstorms over the 2-day period. By Saturday morning a strong cold front is forecast to arrive and bring additional thunderstorms. This front should clear Ponte Vedra Beach by noon Saturday with dry conditions for the remainder of the weekend. Gusty winds will develop behind the front on Saturday with peak gusts over 30mph at times. Much colder temperatures are forecast this weekend.
